

## Samsung Galaxy Tab S3 now in India at Rs 47,990

**New Delhi,** After launching it at the Mobile World Congress in Barcelona, Spain, in February, Samsung Electronics on Tuesday brought Galaxy Tab S3 to India, featuring an advanced S Pen.

The Rs 47,990 Galaxy Tab S3 with Quad speakers tuned by AKG and HDR-ready display delivers superior video and gaming experience along with multi-tasking capabilities.

The device will be available in black and silver colours across retail stores, starting June 20.

"The powerful Galaxy Tab S3 is built with premium technology that offers a productive and versatile experience to consumers, designed for users at home, work or on the go," Vishal Kaul, Director, Mobile Business, Samsung India, said in a statement.

The S Pen does not require any charging or pairing and boasts a fine 0.7mm tip. For a safe and secure login, Samsung Flow feature uses biometric authentication to login and can wirelessly tether compatible

devices to transfer documents from a mobile device to a tablet.

It comes with Quad speakers tuned by AKG, fast-charging capability and 6,000mAh battery which supports 12 hours of video playback.

The speakers' intelligent Auto Rotate Stereo function allows the tablet to redirect sound based on its orientation. With a 9.7-inch Super-AMOLED display and 6mm thin metal frame, the device is powered by a Qualcomm Snapdragon 820 processor (Quad Core 2.15GHz + 1.6GHz), 4GB RAM and has 32GB internal memory that is expandable up to 256GB. The device runs Android 7.0 Nougat.

The device is powered by the Vulkan API and GPU for superior graphics and Game Launcher with a 'Do Not Disturb' mode for uninterrupted gameplay.

The tablet houses a 13MP auto focus rear camera with flash and a 5MP front camera and supports Pogo keyboards that require no separate charging or pairing.

## FIR registered on fake order linking land records to Aadhaar

**New Delhi,** The Delhi Police has registered an FIR over a fake government letter circulated on the social media ordering digitisation of land records and linking them to Aadhaar number, officials said on Tuesday.

Deputy Commissioner of Police, B.K. Singh told IANS that it was difficult to find out the origin of the letter as it was being circulated through the social media.

On Monday, Sheo Nath Singh, Under Secretary in the Cabinet Secretariat, had filed a police complaint regarding the fake government letter dated June 15.

The fake letter, marked to Chief Secretaries and Additional Chief Secretaries of all states, "orders all land records to be digitised before August 14, 2017 and adds that properties which appropriate action under Benami Transactions (Prohibition) Amendment Act, 2016." The official, in his complaint, said the letter "was neither issued by the office of Cabinet Secretariat nor signed by him".

## Deccan Healthcare to raise Rs 40 crore via IPO on BSE SME platform

**Ahmedabad,** Nutraceutical maker Deccan Healthcare will be launching its initial public offering on the BSE SME Exchange to raise around Rs 40 crore.

The issue, scheduled to stay open from December 18 to 20, will be at a price band of Rs 95 to Rs 100 per equity share with face value of Rs 10 each.

BSE SME Exchange has been set up by the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) to provide Small and Medium Sized Enterprises (SMEs) a platform for raising equity capital for their growth and expansion.

Hyderabad-based Deccan Healthcare said it plans to utilise the proceeds of the IPO for repayment of Rs 8 crore debt, invest on the expansion of manufacturing plant at Rudrapur, Uttarakhand and for other

general corporate purposes. Deccan Healthcare manufactures and sells about 1,500 formulations of micro-nutrients called nutraceuticals for hair care, skin care, heart care, and immunity building.

To drive sales, the company launched BE YOUNG brand through an e-commerce platform.

In 2010, the company set up its own manufacturing facility in Rudrapur, Uttarakhand to produce nutraceuticals in forms such as tablets, capsules, gels, liquids, ointments, and powders.

The company posted an annual turnover of Rs 40 crore in 2018.

## Business Brief Indian equities close flat, banking stocks slip

**Mumbai,** The Indian equity markets on Tuesday trimmed gains to provisionally close on a flat-to-negative note as investors booked profits and banking and FMCG stocks witnessed selling pressure.

However, positive European markets and healthy buying in consumer durables, IT and oil and gas stocks limited the downside.

The wider Nifty of the National Stock Exchange (NSE) ended lower by 4.05 points, or 0.04 per cent, to provisionally close (at 3.30 p.m.) at 9,653.50 points. The 30-scrip Sensitive Index (Sensex) of the BSE, which opened at 31,392.53 points, closed at 31,297.53 points — down 14.04 points, or 0.04 per cent, from its previous close at 31,311.57 points. The Sensex touched a high of 31,392.53 and a low of 31,261.49 points during intra-day trade. The BSE market breadth was bearish — with 1,430 declines and 1,230 advances.

## Recharge smartphone, transfer funds via Hike Wallet

**New Delhi,** Home-grown messaging platform Hike Messenger on Tuesday updated its app to Hike 5.0 that comes with a wallet, supporting fund transfers through Unified Payments Interface (UPI).

With Hike Wallet users can also recharge their phones and pay postpaid bills right from inside the app.

"Hike 5.0 is the biggest update we have released in the history of Hike. We have worked closely with over 100 of our top hikers to build 5.0," Kavin Bharti Mittal, CEO Hike Messenger, told reporters here. The messaging app has also introduced "Blue Packets" which is an envelope that users can insert money into and send to their friends. A "Blue Packet" can be sent to an individual or even a group of friends and users can select how many people in the group should get it. It works on a first come first serve basis and when sent, expires within 24 hours. The new update features multiple themes, a "Magic Selfie" feature that uses machine learning techniques and has brought back "Timeline" in its original form, reducing the app size to 25MB.

## India-born Ishan Palit becomes first non-German board member of TUV SUD

**New Delhi,** Munich-headquartered safety, quality and sustainability solutions company TÄceV SÄceD on Tuesday announced the appointment of India-born Ishan Palit as its global Chief Operating Officer.

The German company, in a statement, said this appointment marks the first time in the 150-year history of the TÄceV organisation that a non-German executive has been designated as member of the board of management.

According to the company, Palit will be responsible for operations and sales across all divisions and geographies, including the German market.

Mumbai-born Palit's career at TÄceV SÄceD spans 23 years, including the founding of the company's India subsidiary in 1994. He studied in the US and the UK and holds a Bachelors Degree from Davidson College, US, a General Degree in Economics from the London School of Economics, UK, and a Masters in Business Administration from Georgia Southern University, US.

## Autodesk appoints Andrew Anagnost as President, CEO

**San Francisco,** Global software firm Autodesk on Tuesday announced Andrew Anagnost as the company's new President and CEO. He will also join Autodesk's board of directors.

Anagnost led engineering for Autodesk Inventor, the company's 3D model-based product design and engineering tool.

"This is an exciting time for Autodesk, and I am thrilled to be taking on the CEO role," Anagnost said in a statement. Anagnost's appointment follows the resignation of Carl Bass, the company's former President and CEO, this February. Anagnost joined Autodesk in 1997 and has held several technical and strategic roles within the company.

"The board and I are delighted that Andrew will lead Autodesk into its next stage of growth," said Crawford W. Beveridge, Chairman of the board, Autodesk. Autodesk also announced that Amar Hanspal, Senior Vice President, Chief Product Officer and interim co-CEO, has decided to leave the company. "I want to thank Amar for his many important contributions to Autodesk's culture and product line over his 30 years with the company," said Anagnost.

## ISB students get Rs 22 lakh a year job offers

**Hyderabad,** Students of the Indian School of Business (ISB) here have secured over 1,113 job offers in the campus placements this year with an average salary of around Rs 22 lakh a year.

Over 400 domestic and international companies made the offers to 903 students of the ISB's flagship Post Graduate Programme in Management (PGP).

The premier business school, which has campuses in Hyderabad and Mohali, this year witnessed an increased demand for leadership roles from government think tanks, and the public and private sectors.

It witnessed a 39 per cent increase in the number of recruiters participating in the placements season.

Consulting and IT/ITeS sectors continued to be the largest recruiting sectors constituting 20 percent and 21 percent, respectively, of total number of offers followed by BFSI and healthcare & pharma. Besides the regular recruiters such as McKinsey & Co, BCG, Parthenon, AT Kearney, Apple, Microsoft, Citibank, Novartis, Siemens, Amazon, Cognizant and Hindustan Unilever Ltd, there were several new companies such as Jones Lang LaSalle, Havells, Revigo, P&G, Lendingkart, Reliance Jio, Mindtree Consulting, L'Oréal, Bain & Co and Roland Berger.

Among the international companies, Cargill, Apple, Coty Inc, Landmark Group, Baycurrent and

Credit Access Asia were among those who recruited for the first time at the ISB.

For the second consecutive year, the Andhra Pradesh government participated in the recruitment with 21 offers. ISB students were the preferred choice for several public advocacy and strategy roles.

For the first time, they were chosen for roles of executive assistants to district magistrates at select districts in the state. Other roles offered were in the areas of fin-tech, textiles, tourism, and infrastructure.

Over 70 offers were made for leadership roles by leading corporates, including Aditya Birla Group, Citibank, Yes Bank, Philips India Ltd, Tech Mahindra,

MAX, Mytrah Energy and Genpact. Axis Bank continued to hire ISB's women students for their exclusive leadership programme for the third year, with roles across treasury, corporate finance, retail and consumer banking. Making its first appearance on campus, Ashok turing giant, also recruited ISB's women students for leadership positions.

ISB said its alumni, too, continued to do well beyond graduation. The ISB has been ranked No.1 amongst the top 30 global business schools, for a 160 percent increase in salary of its alumni, three years after completion of the programme, as per the Financial Times Global MBA rankings 2017.

## India-US trade win-win situation: India

**New Delhi,** Ahead of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to the US, the Commerce Ministry on Tuesday said bilateral trade was a "win-win" situation for both the countries even though the balance of trade was not in America's favour.

The US had started a review of its trade policy with countries with which it has adverse trade balance, Commerce Secretary Rita Teotia told the media here.

"India is 9th on that list... but we are confident that Indian exports to the US are a win-win for both the countries," she said.

"Our products are cheaper, while the Indian information technology supports the American industry to be much more competitive," she added.

The officer said that where the US government procurement rules required so, Indian companies, like in the pharmaceuticals sector, had set up plants in the US.

"On the other hand, many US companies find it profitable to serve from India and they have thus set up base here,"
